#### **Inclement Weather Information**

Earlier this week a letter was sent home discussing the "Emergency Closure of Schools". As the weather begins to turn colder this is an important document to review carefully. In particular the information located in sections two and sections three of the letter:

- 1. Closure procedures due to weather will be initiated as early as possible and before students are picked up by the school bus in the morning. Once school begins for the day, school will not be closed because of weather conditions until regular dismissal time. At their discretion, a parent may choose to pick up their child from school at any time. Should it be deemed unsafe to dismiss students at the usual time, students may be kept at the school until it is deemed safe to depart, or until other arrangements have been made.
- 2. Decisions to close school because of inclement weather or other emergencies will be announced on radio stations, CBC Radio, CHFM Lite 96, 66 CFR, JACK FM, QR 77, Q 107, Country 105, CKMX 1060, CJAY 92 as well as

CITY TV, AIR 106 (Airdrie) and Global News Morning Edition. This information will also be posted on the Rocky View Schools' website, Facebook and Twitter and available by telephoning the RVS Transportation information line 403.250.0016.

In addition to these sources Banded Peak School will initiate a call to all parents via our Synervoice service and will post to our Facebook and Twitter Pages in the event of a school closure.

#### **Hour-Zero**




